- » Our team is working hard to do our part in keeping Everyone Safe

- » Machine washable cloth toys are washed daily
- » Postponed all enrichment classes and therapist visits
- » Offering virtual tours to ensure we do not have any new individuals inside the building
- » Tutoring for school age students
- » Cleaning and sanitizing and surfaces and objects that are frequently touched, especially toys and games must be cleaned. This includes cleaning objects/surfaces not ordinarily cleaned daily such as doorknobs, light switches, classroom sink handles, countertops, nap pads, toilet training potties, desks, chairs, cubbies, and playground structures.

- ✓ Please ring doorbell at the health check window
- ✓ Parent must sign child in
- ✓ Parent and staff must complete health and safety check together
- ✓ Staff will receive your child (ren) and their belongs in a plastic disposable bag

AT PICK UP DO'S

- ✓ ALL ADULTS ENTERING THE BUILDING MUST WAER A MUSK DURUNG ALL INTERACTION
- ✓ Please ring doorbell at the health check window
- ✓ Staff will bring your child (ren) and their belongs to you in a plastic disposable bag
- ✓ Parent and staff must complete health and safety check together
- ✓ Parent must sign child out
- ✓ Parent must put their child(ren) shoes on

DON'T

- X Do not enter building
- X No cloth diaper bags. Please use disposable plastic bags
- X Temperatures over 100 degrees cannot attend school
- X Temperatures under 97 degrees cannot be allowed to stay
